What do camp days look like?

- Mornings** Mornings start with breakfast, spending one-on-one time with God, worship music, and a training seminar. Before lunch, we divide into small groups to discuss the lesson and spend time with paired accountability partners.
- Afternoons** Lunch is at noon followed by groups games. The majority of the afternoon is spent at the lake swimming, boating, and on other lake activities. If you don't want to go to the lake, the time is yours to play our other games like basketball, sand volleyball, chat with friends, or rest.
- Evenings** Dinner is around 6 PM. After dinner, we organize tournaments in basketball and volleyball, open to everyone. Evening worship starts after everyone cleans up, and then we have our evening activities and message. The day concludes with some free time and cabin devotions.

Questions???

- What is the dress code?** The dress at camp is totally casual; shorts, shirts, sandals, and the like. We **do not allow bikinis, monokinis, or guys speedos**. If you're wearing a shirt to cover a two-piece swimsuit, make sure the shirt is not see through. **No strapless, spaghetti strap, or low cut tops or dresses are allowed**. We also that you not wear **apparel supporting crude, violent, or sexually explicit movies, TV shows, music artists, or the like**. Guys will not wear their pants too low and girls will wear fingertip length shorts, skirts, or dresses. Please **keep a standard of dress that would be appropriate for a Christian camp**. We will have to speak with you at camp if these rules are not followed.
- What about insurance?** Each camper is provided with a supplemental medical policy. Note that this only takes effect after your personal insurance and the insurance of your church/group stops paying.
- What about calling home?** We have a phone available for collect calls and calling cards. **No cell phones are allowed!!!**
- Sleeping arrangements?** You'll sleep in our comfortable cabins, divided by gender. Each cabin has bunk beds, full bathrooms with private showers, living space, and air conditioning.
- What money is needed?** During camp, campers have the opportunity to buy CTR products like shirts, tanks, hoodies, water bottles, and more! Prices range from \$.50 to \$30. The campus Snak Shak is open to buy chips, candy, pop, ice cream, and other snacks. NEAT ADDITION: We produce a Camp Experience DVD for each camp. The DVD includes hundreds of digital pictures and video from YOUR camp. You Can buy the DVD at camp for \$15 or call after camp and buy it for \$15 plus shipping and we'll mail it.

Table Rock Lake is one of the cleanest lakes in the USA, still testing at drinking water quality! Nestled in the Mark Twain National Forest and surrounded by the Ozark Mountains, we could not find a more beautiful place to have a life-changing camp!

THE LAW AND CAMPER CONTRACT

To ensure that everyone has a safe and awesome time, while growing in their relationship with God while at CTR, there are rules and guidelines we have set. Over years of your ministry, we have discovered there are things that enhance camp experiences and those that detract from it. Our goal is to provide you with an effective camp, and we want absolutely nothing to take away from that.

Below are rules that we have prayerfully created for camp. A description of each offense type is below:

CLASS-A FELONY

A Class-A Felony endangers you, others, or the ministry. As such, we cannot tolerate it and violators will be sent home *immediately* at their parents' expense.

CLASS-B MISDEMEANOR

A Class-B Misdemeanor represents disrespect for God's Holy Word and Law, the camp facilities, or the camp staff. A violation of this respect will result in the camper being put in "detention" (i.e. helping with camp jobs or staying in their cabin for 24 hours).

CLASS-C UH-OH

A Class-C Uh-Oh happens when people just aren't paying attention and do something inappropriate. If a camper does this, they will be given simple duties like chapel clean up, dock clean up, campground trash, kitchen duty, etc.

- Possession and use of nonprescription drugs, alcohol, or tobacco.
- Intentional destruction or damage of property. You will also pay for the damages.
- Breaking curfew and sneaking out of cabins.
- Guys in girls' cabins, or girls in guys' cabins.
- Use of fireworks.
- Possession of fireworks or air horns.
- Being on the dock or in the water any time other than staff supervised lake time.
- Fighting or causing intentional bodily harm to others.
- Disobedience to the instructions of an adult sponsor or staff member.
- Possession of sexually explicit material (magazines, movies, music, or on electronics).
- Skipping out on a worship service or training seminar.
- Wearing apparel with sexual connotations, alcohol logos, etc.
- Disobeying boating rules.
- Use of walkie-talkie, stereo, radio, computer, or cell phone.
- Inappropriate PDA.
- Feeding any camp pets.
- No pets are allowed. If you bring one, your pet will be sent home at your expense.
- Wearing an inappropriate outfit or swimsuit. (See dress code on page 2)

ACTIVITY PERMISSION FORM

Parents and Legal Guardians:

A huge part of the camps offered by Fun in the Son Ministries are the water activities for students. Every activity is carefully monitored and safely conducted.

All campers participating in water activities are required to wear a United States Coast Guard approved life vest, which we provide. All campers will be informed of safety rules before ever boarding a boat and are required to follow those rules.

It is also very important that you as parents and guardians understand the inherent risk of the water activities. We respect and honor your rights as parents and guardians to determine the activities of your teenagers. We only allow students to participate in water activities with your permission. **It is very important that you realize Fun in the Son Ministries carries NO insurance for cliff jumping and wave runner rides.** Other water activities are covered.

Without this permission form, students WILL NOT be allowed to attend camp. No exceptions!
